



The Engineerium itself is closed at the moment, but the **Personalised Travel Planning office is open to the public from 12-6pm weekdays until 30th September 2009.**



1. Front Entrance to Engineerium in The Droveway. Go inside gates and turn immediately left, walking across the courtyard and past the tower.



2. Walk through the 'passageway' running between the right hand side of the tower and the railings in front of the building on your right, and follow the pathway through the arches.



3. Walk towards the house along the access road, keeping the fencing (Southern Water site) on your right.



4. The office (with its cream-coloured ornamental ironwork) is at the back of the house.



By bus

5B - Alight at the Co-op (Nevill Rd). The Droveway is on the same side as Co-op. The Engineerium is on your left on the Droveway.

27A - From the city centre, alight at "Hove Park" stop in Goldstone Crescent, alongside Hove Park. Cross the park, then follow the pathway leading out of the park alongside the miniature railway. Walk up the incline. The Engineerium is on your right.



By Bike

Bikes can be brought into the site and may be locked to the railings directly outside the JourneyOn office.



By Car

There is **no public parking** at the Engineerium.
